**EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY: LAND COORDINATOR**

**RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Work with Executive Director and Land Acquisition Committee (LAC) chairman to pursue new potential projects for conservation value and feasibility, and complete due diligence activities and documentation for all transactions.
- Present potential projects to the LAC and the Board.
- Communicate with landowners, realtors, and other agents during and after the land transactions.
- Ensure that all land transactions meet Land Trust Alliance (LTA) Standards and Practices and work with Executive Director to ensure that SALT land operations meet LTA accreditation requirements.
- Perform annual monitoring on all SALT properties and easements.
- Work with the Weeks Bay National Estuarine Research Reserve (WBNERR) to prioritize acquisitions that add to the Reserve and other collaborative projects.
- Coordinate with volunteers and partners to promote environmental education, restoration and enhancement activities.
- Communicate with the general public about the importance of land conservation and effective land management.
