<i>Callicarpa americana</i>	American Beautyberry	deciduous, showy magenta fruit
<i>Calycanthus floridus</i>	Sweetshrub	deciduous
<i>Cartrema americana</i>	American Olive	evergreen
<i>Cephalanthus occidentalis</i>	Buttonbush	deciduous, showy flowers, grows wet
<i>Chionanthus virginicus</i>	Fringetree	deciduous, showy white flowers
<i>Euonymus americanus</i>	Strawberry Bush	small, deciduous; showy fruit
<i>Fothergilla milleri</i>	Dwarf Witch Hazel	small, deciduous, showy white flowers
<i>Hamamelis virginiana</i>	Witch Hazel	small to medium, deciduous
<i>Hydrangea quercifolia</i>	Oakleaf Hydrangea	small to medium, deciduous, showy flowers
<i>Illicium floridanum</i>	Florida Anise	fragrant evergreen
<i>Ilex verticillata</i>	Winterberry	deciduous, showy red fruit
<i>Ilex vomitoria</i>	Yaupon Holly	small to medium, evergreen, females: showy fruit
<i>Itea virginica</i>	Virginia Sweetspire	small, deciduous, showy flowers
<i>Kalmia latifolia</i>	Mountain Laurel	medium/large, evergreen, showy white/pink flowers
<i>Leucothoe axillaris</i>	Coast Doghobble	small, evergreen
<i>Lyonia lucida</i>	Shining Fetterbush	small, evergreen
<i>Morella cerifera</i>	Wax Myrtle	small to large, evergreen
<i>Rhapidophyllum hystrix</i>	Needle Palm	medium shrub-sized palm
<i>Rhododendron alabamense</i>	Alabama Azalea	medium/large, deciduous, fragrant white flowers
<i>Rhododendron arborescens</i>	Sweet Azalea	medium/large, deciduous, fragrant white flowers
<i>Rhododendron austrinum</i>	Florida Flame Azalea	medium/large, deciduous, fragrant orange flowers
<i>Rhododendron canescens</i>	Piedmont Azalea	medium/large, deciduous, fragrant pink flowers
<i>Rhododendron colemanii</i>	Red Hills Azalea	medium/large, deciduous, various colored flowers
<i>Rhododendron serrulatum</i>	Hammock Sweet Azalea	medium, deciduous, fragrant pink-white flowers
<i>Rhododendron viscosum</i>	Swamp Azalea	medium, deciduous, clammy white fragrant flowers
<i>Sabal minor</i>	Dwarf Palmetto	medium shrub-sized palm
<i>Sassafras albidum</i>	Sassafras	small, deciduous
<i>Serenoa repens</i>	Saw Palmetto	shrub-sized palm
<i>Styrax americanus</i>	American Snowbell	small, deciduous, showy white flowers
<i>Vaccinium arboreum</i>	Sparkleberry	medium, evergreen
<i>Vaccinium virgatum</i>	Rabbit Eye Blueberry	medium, deciduous, delicious fruits
<i>Vaccinium darrowii</i>	Darrow's Blueberry	small, evergreen, tiny delicious fruits
<i>Vaccinium myrsinites</i>	Shiny Blueberry	small, evergreen, tiny delicious fruits
<i>Vaccinium stamineum</i>	Deerberry	medium, deciduous, delicious fruits
<i>Viburnum acerifolium</i>	Maple-leaf Viburnum	small, deciduous
<i>Viburnum nudum</i>	Possumhaw Viburnum	medium, deciduous

Perennials (including ferns)

<i>Ampelaster carolinianus</i>	Climbing Aster	pollinator magnet, needs room to spread
<i>Amsonia tabernaemontana</i>	Blue Star	deciduous, small blue flowers in spring
<i>Asclepias incarnata</i>	Swamp Milkweed	tall, pink flowers
<i>Asclepias obovata</i>	Pineland Milkweed	reclining, creamy pinkish flowers
<i>Asclepias tuberosa</i>	Butterfly Milkweed	medium, deep orange/red flowers
<i>Asclepias variegata</i>	Redring Milkweed	tall, large leaves, white flowers w/red ring
<i>Asclepias verticillata</i>	Whorled Milkweed	single stem, narrow leaves, creamy white flowers

<i>Asclepias viridis</i>	Spider Milkweed	reclining, light green flowers
<i>Baptisia alba</i>	Wild White Indigo	deciduous, white flowers in spring
<i>Baptisia australis</i>	Blue False Indigo	deciduous, blue flowers in spring
<i>Coreopsis integrifolia</i>	Chipola River Tickseed	patch-forming, yellow flowers in fall
<i>Dyschoriste oblongifolia</i>	Twin Flower	patch-forming, lavender flowers in spring
<i>Dryopteris ludoviciana</i>	Southern Wood Fern	medium, clumper, semi-evergreen
<i>Echinacea purpurea</i>	Purple Coneflower	purple flowers spring – late summer
<i>Erythrina herbacea</i>	Coral Bean	deciduous, showy red flowers and fruits
<i>Glandularia canadensis</i>	Homestead Purple Verbena	patch-forming, low-growing, purple flowers
<i>Helianthus angustifolius</i>	Narrow-leaf Sunflower	tall, flowers late summer/early fall
<i>Hibiscus coccineus</i>	Scarlet Hibiscus	tall, deciduous, large deep red flowers
<i>Hibiscus grandiflorus</i>	Swamp Hibiscus	tall, deciduous, large pink flowers
<i>Hibiscus moscheutos</i>	Swamp Rosemallow	tall, deciduous, large pink flowers
<i>Hymenocallis occidentalis</i>	Spider Lily	deciduous, large white flowers
<i>Hypericum frondosum</i>	Golden St. John's Wort	medium, semi-woody, evergreen, yellow flowers
<i>Hypericum reductum</i>	Sandhill St. John's Wort	small, semi-woody, evergreen, yellow flowers
<i>Iris verna</i>	Dwarf Woodland Iris	low-growing, lavender and yellow flowers
<i>Iris virginica</i>	Southern Blue Flag	medium, evergreen, lavender and yellow flowers
<i>Liatris spicata</i>	Blazing Star	tall, deciduous, single stems, spikes of purple flowers
<i>Mitchella repens</i>	Partridge Berry	groundcover, evergreen, white flowers, red fruit
<i>Monarda punctata</i>	Dotted Horsemint	spreading mint, deciduous, yellow flowers
<i>Penstemon laevigatus</i>	Beardtongue	deciduous, pink flowers in spring
<i>Penstemon multiflorus</i>	White Beardtongue	deciduous, tall, white flowers in spring, rare
<i>Phlox divaricata</i>	Blue Phlox	tall, semi-evergreen, flowers late spring - summer
<i>Phlox paniculata</i>	Fall Phlox	lavender flowers summer – fall
<i>Pityopsis graminifolia</i>	Narrowleaf Silkgrass	grass-like leaves, yellow flowers in fall
<i>Rudbeckia fulgida</i>	Black-eyed Susan	evergreen, yellow flowers in summer
<i>Ruellia caroliniensis</i>	Wild Petunia	seeds freely, purple flowers spring – summer
<i>Silene regia</i>	Royal Catchfly	multi-stemmed, deciduous, bright red flowers
<i>Sisyrinchium</i> spp.	Blue-eyed Grass	grass-like groundcover, blue flowers
<i>Solidago odora</i>	Sweet Goldenrod	fragrant leaves, yellow flowers in fall
<i>Solidago stricta</i>	Slender Goldenrod	yellow flowers in fall
<i>Vernonia angustifolia</i>	Ironweed	purple flowers in fall
<i>Zephyranthes atamasco</i>	Atamasco Lily	white flowers early spring

<i>Eragrostis elliotii</i>	Elliott's Love Grass	small
<i>Eragrostis spectabilis</i>	Purple Love Grass	small
